BGR Seeking Nominations of Public Employees and Citizens for 2020 Excellence in Government Awards

New Orleans (December 18, 2019) – The Bureau of Governmental Research (BGR) is now accepting nominations for its 2020 Excellence in Government Awards. Since 1994, BGR has given more than 150 Excellence in Government awards to extraordinary public employees and private citizens. The awards honor creative, dedicated public employees for their accomplishments and citizens who have worked to significantly improve local government. The deadline for nominations is February 14, 2020.

There are four Excellence in Government award categories. The Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes sustained performance over a career in public service. The Merit Award recognizes outstanding performance by public sector employees. The Innovation Award recognizes employees who have implemented new solutions to pressing problems. Finally, the Citizenship Award recognizes a private citizen who has worked to improve the quality of government. All public employee awards include a cash award.

Glovinsky, BGR President & CEO. “This is an exciting part of our mission where BGR recognizes those who are actively working for and facilitating efficient and effective government.
